

Exceptions will permit vehicles to wait on the length of road concerned in connection with:

- (i) building or demolition works;
- (ii) the maintenance of the road;
- (iii) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (iv) works to any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (v) a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (vi) a vehicle being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (vii) a vehicle being used by or on behalf of a local authority for the collection of household refuse or the clearing of cesspools;
- (viii) a vehicle waiting for any gate or other barrier to be opened or closed at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged;
- (ix) a vehicle waiting when the person in control of it is required by law to stop; is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date hereunder apply to the High Court for this purpose.

FAREHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Fareham (Osborn Road South, Fareham) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that Fareham Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day other than Sunday in the length of Osborn Road South, Fareham, from a point approximately 100 feet from the junction with West Street, on the west side, for a distance of approximately 140 feet up to and including the entrance to the police station.

Exemptions to the Order will permit waiting for certain purposes including picking up and setting down passengers; loading or unloading goods; building operations, road and similar works.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the road concerned together with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during usual office hours.

Objections to the proposals should be sent in writing, stating the grounds thereof, to the undersigned by 27th June 1979.
