Notice is hereby given that the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, proposes to amend the County Council of South Glamorgan (Cardiff Central Area) (Parking Control) Order 1978 by substituting the restrictions shown below for those operating at present.

(a) No Waiting At Any Time

Fitzalan Place, on its south-west side, from a point 15.2 metres south-east of its junction with Newport Road to a point 55 metres south-east of the same junction and from a point 15.2 metres north-west of its junction with Fitzalan Road to a point 30 metres north-west of the same junction. (The peak hour loading and unloading ban will remain).

Hayes Bridge Road, on its south-west side, from a point 61 metres south-east of its junction with New Street in a south-easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.

Mary Ann Street, on its north-east side, from a point 37 metres north-west of the junction with Bute Terrace for a distance of 15 metres north-west.

David Street, on its south-west side, from a point 6.1 metres north-west of its junction with Bute Terrace to a point 16 metres north-west of the same junction and from a point 52 metres south-east of the junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 30 metres southeast, and on its north-east side from a point 46 metres north-west of its junction with Bute Terrace for a distance of 7 metres north-west and from a point 826 metres north-west of its junction with Bute Terrace for a distance of 10 metres north-west.

David Street, on its south-west side, from a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with Bridge Street to a point 52 metres south-east of the same junction.

Park Place, on its north-east side, from a point 72.5 metres north of its junction with Queen Street to its junction with Greyfriars Road.

Westgate Street, on its north-east side, from a point 15.2 metres north-west of its junction with Quay Street north-west for a distance of 36.6 metres.

Exemptions will be permitted for the following reasons:

(a) Boarding and alighting from a vehicle.
(b) Loading and unloading of goods.
(c) Essential services and funerals.
(d) For a maximum period of two hours, vehicles when displaying an "Orange Badge" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.
