Warrington Street from the north kerb-line of Bow Street to the south kerb-ilne of the north access to the Market Place.

(b) To prohibit driving, except for buses and for vehicles wishing to load and unload, on:

Old Street from the west kerb-line of the Precinct access road to Warrington Street.

The southerly half of Old Street between Delamere Street and the west kerb-line of the Precinct access road.

Warrington Street from Stamford Street to the north kerb-line of Old Street.

(c) To prohibit driving, except for buses at any time and for vehicles wishing to load and unload between 5 p.m. one day and 11 a.m. the following day on:

Warrington Street from the north kerb-line of Old Street to the north kerb-line of Bow Street.

(d) To prohibit driving except for vehicles wishing to load and unload on:

Wellington Street from Delamere Street to George Street.

Duke Street from Delamere Street to George Street. Duke Street for its entire length.

(e) To prohibit driving except for vehicles wishing to load and unload between 5 p.m. one day and 11 a.m. the following day on:

Bow Street for its entire length.

Old Street from Market Street to Warrington Street.

- (f) To impose one way working on:
 - Bow Street from Warrington Street to Market Street in that direction.
 - Old Street from Market Street to Warrington Street in that direction.
 - Wellington Street from Warrington Street to George Street in that direction.

Wellington Street from Warrington Street to Delamere Street in that direction.

Wood Street from Warrington Street to George Street in that direction.

Wood Street from Warrington Street to Delamere Street in that direction.

George Street from Stamford Street to Old Street in that direction.

(g) To suspend the existing one way working (and reintroduce two-way working) on:

Old Street between Delamere Street and Warrington Street.

Stamford Street between Delamere Street and George Street.

Warrington Street between the south kerb-line of the north access to the Market Place and Jermyn Street.

(h) To prohibit the right hand turn from Stamford Street into Grey Street.

The Greater Manchester County (Delamere Street, Ashtonunder-Lyne) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Experimental) (County) Order 1979

To prohibit waiting at any time on the west side of Delamere Street between Old Street and Stamford Street.

The above Orders contain exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons' vehicles bearing a disabled person's badge and a parking disc will be allowed to wait for periods of two hours, return prohibited within one hour, when a loading/unloading ban is not in operation. The existing waiting restrictions affected by the "Prohibition of Driving" Order will be suspended for the experimental period.
