MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The Mid Glamorgan County Council (Commercial Street, Llantrisant) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any, time on the western side of Commercial Street, Llantrisant from the termination of the current waiting restriction near the "Cross Keys" Public House northwards to the south-eastern corner of its junction with the lane leading to the Town Garage, a distance of 11 metres (12 yards).

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled Persons vehicles displaying the relevant disabled persons badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the Authority's reasons for proposing to make the Order, and a map showing the side of length of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Taff Ely Borough Council, Municipal Buildings, Pontypridd; "Danygraig", Llantrisant and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 2nd July 1979.

SECTION 21*Pedestrian Crossings and Pelican Crossings*

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to vary the Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the county of Mid Glamorgan approved by the Secretary of State for Wales on 25th August 1978 by the replacement of the existing "Zebra" crossing at the site described below by a signal-controlled "Pelican" crossing:

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Gloucestershire County Council (Prestbury) (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 4th June 1979 the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effects of which are:

1. To vary "the Gloucestershire County Council (Prestbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1974" by the deletion of Item 1 of the Schedule to that Order (the prohibition of the waiting of vehicles in "Prestbury Road (A46) from its junction with Glebe Road (unclassified) to its junction with Tatchley Lane (B4075) and Bouncers Lane (B4075)").

2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the parts of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions to paragraph 2 above permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) Building industrial or demolition operations; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads or services therein;
- (c) The removal of any obstructions to traffic;
- (d) In pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) The delivery or collection of mail by a vehicle in the service of or employed by the Post Office;
- (f) Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (g) Loading and unloading goods.

The usual exemptions apply for disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 19th June 1979, together with the relevant map, may be inspected during all reasonable hours at the offices of the Gloucestershire County Council at the Shire Hall, Gloucester, the Cheltenham Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Promenade, Cheltenham and the Tewkesbury Borough Council, Council Offices, Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Parish of Prestbury District of Tewkesbury Borough

1. *Prestbury Road (A46)*, north side, from its junction with Tatchley Lane (B4075) for a distance of 116 metres in a south-westerly direction.

South side, from its junction with Bouncers Lane (B4075) to its junction with Glebe Road (unclassified).
