<i>Lengths of Road in the Parish of Wallingford</i>	<i>Permitted Direction</i>
1. <i>Goldsmith's Lane</i> , from its junction with St. Leonard's Square to its junction with Mill Lane.	From west to east.
2. <i>Market Place</i> (1) Carriageway on the west side of the Town Hall, from its junction with St. Martin's Street (south) to a point 65 metres north of Church Lane. (2) The remainder except the carriageway on the west side between the length specified in (1) above and St. Martin's Street (north).	From south to north.
3. <i>New Road</i> , that length between its junction with Thames Street and the car park entrance.	From north to south.
4. <i>St. Mary's Street</i> , from Market Place to New Road.	From east to west.
5. <i>St. Martin's Street</i> , from St. Leonard's Square to its junction with Market Place.	From north to south.
6. <i>Thames Street</i> , from its junction with New Road to its junction with St. Peter's Street.	From south to north.
7. <i>Wood Street</i> , from its junction with High Street for a distance of 12 metres.	From north to south.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Roads in the Parish of Wallingford

Part 1. No Waiting At Any Time

1. *Castle Street*, both sides:
(1) from its junction with High Street for a distance of 65 metres north; and
(2) from a point 160 metres north of High Street for a distance of 185 metres north.
2. *Croft Road*, both sides:
(1) from its junction with St. John's Road for a distance of 60 metres north; and
(2) from its junction with High Street for a distance of 115 metres south.
3. *Goldsmith's Lane*
(1) *East side*:
(i) from its junction with High Street for a distance of 190 metres; and
(ii) from a point 240 metres from its junction with High Street to its junction with St. Leonard's Square;
(2) *West side*, from its junction with High Street to its junction with St. Leonard's Square.
4. *Hart Street*, both sides, the whole length.
5. *High Street*
(1) *North Side*, from its junction with St. George's Road to its junction with Castle Lane.
(2) *South side*:
(i) from its junction with Croft Road east for a distance of 50 metres east;
(ii) from a point 50 metres west of Goldsmith's Lane to the west abutment of Wallingford Bridge.

6. *Kine Croft*, south side, the whole length.
7. *Market Place*.
8. *New Road*, both sides, the whole length.
9. *Queens Avenue*, both sides of the main carriageway.
19. *Reading Road*, both sides, from its junction with St. John's Road for a distance of 110 metres south.
11. *St. Alban's car park access road*, both sides the whole length.
12. *St. George's Road*, both sides, from its junction with High Street for a distance of 115 metres north.
13. *St. John's Road*, both sides:
(1) from its junction with Reading Road for a distance of 110 metres west; and
(2) from a point 70 metres east of its junction with Croft Road for a distance of 180 metres west.
14. *St. Leonard's Square*,
(1) the north, south and east sides.
(2) *west side*:
(i) from its junction with Goldsmith's Lane for a distance of 3 metres north; and
(ii) from a point 18 metres north of its junction with Goldsmith's Lane to its junction with St. Martin's Street.
15. *St. Martin's Street*, both sides, the whole length.
16. *St. Mary's Street*, both sides, from its junction with St. John's Road to its junction with Market Place.
17. *St. Peter's Street*
(1) North side, from its junction with Thames Street for a distance of 50 metres west.
(2) South side, the whole length.
18. *Station Road*, both sides, from its junction with Croft Road for a distance of 70 metres.
19. *Thames Street*
(1) Both sides, from its junction with High Street for a distance of 122 metres south.
(2) West side, from its junction with New Road for a distance of 15 metres south.
20. *Wood Street*, both sides:
(1) from its junction with High Street for a distance of 30 metres south; and
(2) from a point 20 metres north of its junction with New Road for a distance of 35 metres south.

Part II. No Waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.

1. *Croft Road*, both sides, from a point 60 metres north of its junction with St. John's Road to a point 115 metres south of its junction with High Street.
2. *Station Road*, both sides, from a point 70 metres west of its junction with Croft Road for a distance of 185 metres west.
3. *St. John's Road*, both sides, from a point 110 metres west of its junction with Reading Road to a point 70 metres east of its junction with Croft Road.
4. *Wood Street*, both sides, from its junction with St. Leonard's Lane to a point 15 metres south of its junction with New Road.
5. *Wood Street*
(1) East side, from a point 20 metres south of its junction with High Street for a distance of 33 metres south.
(2) West side, from a point 20 metres north of its junction with New Road to a point 30 metres south of its junction with High Street.

Part III. No Waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday.

The Layby on the west side of St. George's Road, Wallingford from a point 103 metres north of the junction with Station Road to a point 209 metres north of the said junction (a distance of 106 metres).

Part IV. Waiting Limited to a period of 30 minutes—no return within one hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday.

1. *Castle Street*, west side, from a point 65 metres north of its junction with High Street for a distance of 95 metres north.
2. *High Street*
(1) North side, from its junction with Castle Lane to the west abutment of Wallingford Bridge.
