TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of lengths of the C237 road at Kinsley, Bradford on Avon, Wiltshire to enable residential development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to the executors of the late Colonel S. G. Walker and others.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new highway maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Wiltshire County Council.

Chancellor) at the Main Hall, Sande Place Middle School, Park Road, Sandy, Bedfordshire, on Tuesday, 24th July 1979 at 10.30 a.m. to hear representations from persons who have objected to the Side Roads Order, representations from persons interested in the land comprised in the Compulsory Purchase Order and at his discretion to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

A copy of the Side Roads Order, which has been prepared in draft by the Secretary of State under the Highways Acts 1959 to 1971 and of the plan referred to therein and a copy of the Compulsory Purchase Order, which has been prepared in draft by the Minister of Transport under the several Acts stated at the head of this notice, and of the plan referred to therein have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 8th June 1979 at the offices of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Eastern Region, Heron House, 49-51 Goldington Road, Bedford; Bedfordshire County Council, County Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford; Mid-Bedfordshire District Council, 12 Dunstable Street, Ampthill, Beds; Sandy Town Council, 10 Cambridge Road, Sandy, Beds (open 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Monday to Friday only); Sandy Library, Market Square, Sandy, Beds and at Beeston Post Office, Beeston, Sandy, Beds.

If made the Orders will authorise the Minister of Transport to improve the Trunk Road, the Sandy—Bedford Road (A603), London Road and Bedford Road (B1042), stop up the northern carriageway of London Road at its southern junction with the trunk road, stop up the northern carriageway of the A603 at its northern junction with the trunk road, construct a new highway, stop up private means of access to premises, provide new means of access to premises, all at Sandy, Bedfordshire and to purchase compulsorily the land described in the compulsory purchase Order for the purposes of the improvement of the trunk road and Bedford Road (B1042) and the construction of a new highway.

Objectors are reminded that the substance of their objections or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected by them; that they will be passed to the Inspector holding the inquiry; and that in that event the Inspector may be required to disclose the objections or representations and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the authors.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Hampshire (A287 Odiham Bypass Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1978

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modification the above Order which was made by the County Council of Hampshire under sections 1, 3 and 62 of the Highways Act 1971 and which, as confirmed, authorises the council:

- to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- to stop up highways,
- to construct new highways,
- to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- to provide new means of access to premises,

which the Council are proposing to construct between a point on the A32 road approximately 150 metres south of all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road the Lord Derby Public House to the junction of the A27 road with Broad Oak Lane (U243) at Odiham, Hampshire.
