SCHEDULE

Sides of Roads at Durham City in Durham District

(a) *Franklands Lane/Sidegate*, north-west side, commencing at a point on Franklands Lane 15 yards north-east of the access to Crook Hall Farm and extending for a distance of 75 yards in a south-westerly direction to Sidegate.

(b) *Franklands Lane/Framwelgate Waterside*, south-east side, commencing at a point on Franklands Lane 15 yards north-east of the access to Crook Hall Farm and extending for a distance of 58 yards in a south-westerly direction to Framwelgate Waterside.

(c) *Sidegate*, south-west side, commencing at its junction with Framwelgate Waterside and extending for a distance of 25 yards in a north-westerly direction. (776)

DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Durham (Victoria Road Area, Consett) (Experimental Traffic Management) (No. 1) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 7th June 1979 the County Council of Durham made an Order under sections 9 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 9th June 1979 will be to impose the following restrictions on traffic in streets at Consett in Derwentside District:

- (a) prohibition of waiting by vehicles at any time on *Victoria Road*, south-west side, from its junction with Raglan Street to its junction with Front Street.
- (b) prohibition of waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day on:
 - (i) *Wesley Street*, south-east side, from its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Middle Street.
 - (ii) *Queen Street*, south-east side, from its junction with Victoria Road to a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Middle Street.

The Order contains exemptions in respect of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading of goods, Post Office vehicles, maintenance of the roads, statutory powers, police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes and disabled persons vehicles.

Prohibition of right hand turn from Raglan Street into Victoria Road.

Prohibition of left hand turn from Pitt Street into Victoria Road.

The prohibition of right and left hand turns will be subject to exemptions in respect of street cleansing vehicles and emergency vehicles.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 6 months and may be extended.
