HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Beverley Borough) (Trinity Lane, Beverley and South Street, Cottingham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Kent County Council (High Street, Smarden) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Kent County Council proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which would be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, on the north-west side of High Street, Smarden, from its junction with Water Lane to a point 3 metres north-east of the south-west boundary of Old School House.

Exceptions would be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight from the vehicle; for the loading or unloading of goods; for enabling works to be carried out in or adjacent to the road and for disabled persons.

The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Amendment) (Golf Course Lane/Western Park Boulevard/Scudamore Road) (No.) Order 1979.

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Lincolnshire County Council (Various Roads, Skegness) (Prohibition of Use of Highways by Public Service Vehicles) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 15 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and by Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit public service vehicles from proceeding in the undermentioned roads in Skegness:

(1) *Park Avenue*, between Castleton Boulevard and Scarborough Avenue.

(2) *Lumley Avenue*, between Castleton Boulevard and Scarborough Avenue.

(3) *Rutland Road*, whole length.

Exemption for access to premises on the affected lengths of roads and to culs-de-sac which cannot be obtained from any other public highway will be included in the Order.
