Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to:

Oldham Road, Springhead

North side from the Lees/Saddleworth boundary for 78 metres east.

North side from a point 40 metres west of Bridge Street to a point 10 metres east of that Street.

North side from a point 27 metres west of Walkers Lane to a point 20 metres east of that street.

North side from Spring Street to Clegg Street.

South side from the Lees/Saddleworth boundary to a point 15 metres east of Cooperative Street.

South side from a point 10 metres west of Atherton Street to a point 10 metres east of that street.

South side from a point 10 metres west of Wroe Street for 60 metres east.

South side from a point 12 metres west of Staley Street to a point 15 metres east of that street.

North side, from a point 20 metres east of Walkers Lane to Spring Street.

North side from Clegg Street to Brooklands Parade.

South side, from a point 15 metres east of Cooperative Street to a point 10 metres west of Atherton Street.

South side, from a point 10 metres east of Atherton Street to a point 10 metres west of Wroe Street.

South side, from a point 45 metres east of Wroe Street to a point 12 metres west of Staley Street.

Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour (except when the loading/unloading ban is in force).

The Northamptonshire County Council (Rockingham Road, Corby) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 31st May 1979 the Northamptonshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of vehicles on that length of the service road on the west side of Rockingham Road, Corby which extends from its junction with the south side of willow brook Road to a point 4 yards south of that junction.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the District Secretary, Corby District Council, Civic Centre, Corby or at the office of the undersigned between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 noon and 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 31st May 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into operation on 11th June 1979.
