

*Description of Public Right of Way**The Parish of Ripley*

Part of Footpath No. 62 which runs from its junction with Footpath No. 107 which runs coincidentally with Coach Road, Ripley, at a point about 220 metres north of the junction of that road with Nottingham Road (A610) in a general east-south-easterly direction to Footpath No. 61, which runs northwards from Nottingham Road adjacent to the eastern side of Codnorgate Farm, being that part which extends from a point about 40 metres east of the cricket ground pavilion in a general east-south-easterly direction for a distance of about 385 metres to a stile on the western side of the dismantled railway.

Description of Alternative Way Proposed to be made Available

From Footpath No. 62 at the point about 40 metres east of the cricket ground pavilion in a general south-south-easterly direction for a distance of about 510 metres to the dismantled railway and then in a general northerly direction along the side of the railway for a distance of about 300 metres to re-join that Footpath at the stile referred to above.—Dated 21st May 1979.
