TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967— SECTION 12(1)

The Trunk Road (Cross Ways Interchange, Woolpit—Quarries Cross Interchange, Haughley) (A45) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 1979.
