Notice is hereby given that on 1st June 1979 the Buckinghamshire County Council made the above-named Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice will become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.

The Order provides for the variation of the County of Buckingham (Built Up Areas) (No. 2) Order 1938, by the deletion therefrom of the length of road described therein as "Wing Rural (Northall) Leighton Buzzard—Hemel Hempstead Road, B486, from the north-western boundary of the "Old Wrestlers" public house, south-eastwards for a distance of 500 yards".

This Order will come into operation on 18th June 1979.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 15th June 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## CHELMSFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Chelmsford (Grove Road, Chelmsford) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 8th June 1979 the Chelmsford Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and under all other enabling powers.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall allow a vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to allow a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable vehicles to be used in connection with building operations, and the maintenance or improvements of the lengths of road or of the services therein.

The proposed Order allows a disabled person's vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc to wait in the length of road for 2 hours in any 3.

The Order together with a map showing the restrictions may be inspected at the Secretary's Department, Civic Centre, Chelmsford during normal office hours.

The Order will come into effect on 11th June 1979, or as soon thereafter as the necessary signs are erected. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation
