COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Colchester Borough (Middle Mill Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Colchester Borough (Oxford Road and Creffield Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Crackington Haven) (Seasonal Restrictions on Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 5th June 1979 the Cornwall County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit (subject to the normal exceptions operating in Cornwall) the waiting of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in any of the lengths of road at Crackington Haven specified in the Schedule hereto.
