

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of Sleetburn Street, Church Terrace, Prospect Place, rear Jubilee Street, Jubilee Street, Harvey Street, part of Bewley Terrace and four unnamed Highways all at New Brancepeth, Durham, to enable development consisting of the reclamation of derelict land to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Durham County Council under Part III of the said Act.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Newcastle-upon-Tyne Metropolitan Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Meldon Street, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, Tyne and Wear. The purpose of the proposal is to enable the Council to improve the amenity of the Area by pedestrianising this length of highway.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (County of Derbyshire) (No. 2) Order 1979" which extinguishes any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on a length of New Street, Alfreton and which was the subject of a local inquiry.

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Amber Valley District Council as the Local Planning Authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable.
