ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967—SECTION 1

The Borough of Ipswich (Raeburn Road) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Ipswich Borough Council ("the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Suffolk County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Local Government Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967 propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from proceeding over that length of Raeburn Road in the Borough of Ipswich that extends from the kerb-line of Sandy Hill Lane along Raeburn Road for a distance of 7 metres in a north-easterly direction.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Shanklin, I.W.) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1, 1979

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 have made an Order the effect of which is as follows:

To revoke The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Shanklin, I.W.) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1, 1978.

To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order subject to the following amendments:

(a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Highfield Road, on east side, from a point 45 feet north to a point 55 feet south of Paddock Road.

Paddock Road, on both sides, from its junction with Highfield Road to a point 45 feet east thereof.

St. Paul's Avenue, on north side, from its junction with Regent Street to a point 80 feet east thereof.

St. Paul's Avenue, on south side, from its junction with Regent Street to a point 50 feet east thereof.

(b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time 1st May to 30th September in the following length of road:

Grange Road, on north side, from a point 100 feet west of its junction with A3055 High Street, to a point 100 feet east of its junction with Pomona Road.

The Order is designed to reduce congestion and delay in the said roads and to facilitate the traffic flow generally in the promotion of road safety and contains exemption clauses to permit loading and unloading of goods where appropriate, and will come into operation on 18th June 1979.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the said Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the said Act, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order, may within 6 weeks of the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.
