

By virtue of Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/286 the British Waterways Board are authorised to abstract the following quantities of water: not exceeding 12 million gallons per day and not exceeding 4,380 million gallons per year.

The variation applied for is:

1. To vary Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/138 by providing that the quantities of water currently authorised to be abstracted under Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/286 may be abstracted by virtue of Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/138 and to revoke Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/286.

2. To provide that the quantities of water authorised to be abstracted by virtue of Licence Serial Number 18/54/20/138 as varied namely: not exceeding 37 million gallons per day and not exceeding 13,505 million gallons per year shall be varied to their metric equivalents namely: not exceeding 170 million litres per day and not exceeding 62,000 million litres per year.

3. To increase as from the date of issue of the variation the maximum quantity of water authorised to be abstracted in any day from 170 million litres to 185 million litres but to leave unchanged the maximum quantity authorised to be abstracted in any year at 62,000 million litres provided that:

(i) The maximum quantity of water to be abstracted in any period of 100 days from the first day in each year when regulating discharges of water are made from the Clywedog Reservoir by virtue of section 46 (2) (b) of the Clywedog Reservoir Joint Authority Act 1963 or by virtue of Provision I of the abstraction licence issued to the Authority in respect of the Shropshire Groundwater Scheme shall not exceed 17,000 million litres and *pro rata* thereafter until the last day in that year when regulating discharges are made.

(ii) On any day when the maximum regulating discharge from Clywedog Reservoir by virtue of the proviso to section 46 (2) (b) of the Clywedog Reservoir Joint Authority Act 1963 is 500 million litres and the maximum regulation discharge from the Authority's Shropshire Groundwater Scheme is limited by virtue of the proviso to Provision I of the abstraction licence issued to the Authority the maximum quantity of water to be abstracted shall not exceed 170 million litres.

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that the Severn-Trent Water Authority (hereinafter called "the Authority") have formulated proposals to vary licence serial number 18/54/8/157 issued by the Severn River Authority to the South-West Worcestershire Water Board on 24th June 1966 and now held by the Authority.

By virtue of the said licence the Authority are entitled to abstract the quantities of water set out below at an intake at National Grid Reference SO 840 565 at Worcester:

Not exceeding 9,200,000 gallons per day nor 3,358,000,000 gallons in any calendar year, equivalent to: 41.8 million litres per day and 15,265 million litres in any calendar year.

The variation proposed is to vary the amount of water authorised to be abstracted in any calendar year to the metric equivalent of the amount currently authorised to be abstracted, namely to 15,265 million litres and to increase the amount of water authorised to be abstracted per day to 47.5 million litres, provided that:

(i) The maximum quantity of water to be abstracted in any period of 100 days from the first day in each year when regulating discharges of water are made from the Clywedog Reservoir by virtue of section 46 (2) (b) of the Clywedog Reservoir Joint Authority Act 1963 or by virtue of Provision I of the abstraction licence issued to the Authority in respect of the Shropshire Groundwater Scheme shall not exceed 41,800 million litres and *pro rata* thereafter until the last day in that year when regulating discharges are made.
