The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Teal Lane, Pickering) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of Over 3 tons and One-Way Traffic) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of North Yorkshire propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, section 1 of the Heavy Commercial Vehicles (Controls and Regulations) Act 1973 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the use of Teal Lane, Pickering by vehicles travelling in a southerly direction and to prohibit the use of that road by heavy commercial vehicles, except for access.

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Great Heck) (Experimental Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of over 3 tons) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of North Yorkshire propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 the effect of which will be to prohibit heavy commercial vehicles from using the following lengths of road except for access:

- (a) *Balne Moor-Gowdall* Class III County Road C340 from its easterly junction with the Great Heck-Little Heck Class III County Road C341 to its junction with the Pollington-Darrington Class III County Road C343;
- (b) *Great Heck-Little Heck* Class III County Road C341, western spur at Great Heck, from its junction with the Balne Moore-Gowdall Class III County Road C340 for a distance of 120 metres in a northerly direction;
- (c) *Great Heck-Hensall* Class III County Road C339 from its junction with the Balne Moor-Gowdall Class III County Road C340 to its junction with the Crofton-Snaith Class I County Road A645;
- (d) the unclassified county roads in the area bounded by the *Crofton-Snaith* Class I County Road A645, the *Doncaster-South Shields* Class I County Road A19 the *Pollington-Darrington* Class III County Road C343, the *Balne Moor-Gowdall* Class III County Road C340 and the *Great Heck-Hensall* Class III County Road C339.

The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (St. Nicholas Street, Norton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of North Yorkshire propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on:

(a) *St. Nicholas Street* :

north side, from its junction with Welham Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres;
south side, from its junction with Welham Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 48 metres.

(b) *Welham Road*, east side, from its junction with St. Nicholas Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

An exemption clause will permit the setting down and picking up of passengers, loading and unloading goods and other essential purposes.
