

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (County of Hampshire) (No. 3) Order 1979" extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on lengths of Palmerston Road and Stanley Street, Southsea, Hampshire.

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Portsmouth City Council as the local planning authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable.
