*Mid Glamorgan County Council (Un-named Roads between Court Street and Berw Road, Tonypanyd) (i) (Revocation and Prohibition of Entry) Order 1979 (ii) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1979.*

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make Orders under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which will be:

- (i) to revoke the "Rhondda Borough Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Entry) (No. 4) Order, 1973" (which prohibits any vehicle from entering the un-named road lying between the Pandy Hotel and the Picturedrome Cinema, Tonypanyd from Llwynypia Road and vice versa);
- (ii) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in either of the roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice to enter the road specified in relation to that road in Column 2 of the said Schedule;
- (iii) to prohibit any vehicle from entering the un-named road lying between the Pandy Hotel and the Picturedrome Cinema, Tonypanyd, from Llwynypia Road unless requiring access to premises on or abutting the road;
- (iv) to prohibit any vehicle, except public service vehicles with a recognised stop on the section, from proceeding in that length of the un-named road between Court Street and Berw Road, Tonypanyd lying immediately to the west of the Pandy Hotel, from its junction with Court Street to a point opposite the southern side of the new access to the District Social Services Offices, a distance of approximately 49 metres (54 yards).

Copies of the proposed Orders a map showing the roads to which the proposed Orders relate and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the offices of the Rhondda Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Pentre, Rhondda and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff during normal office hours.

*Mid Glamorgan County Council (Wigan Terrace (A4065), Bryncethin) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th June 1979 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the sides of lengths of road described in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

The Order came into operation on 22nd June 1979 and a copy thereof and a map showing the sides of lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 22nd June 1979.
