ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

TYNE AND WEAR COUNTY COUNCIL

*(Newcastle Road, A1018, Sunderland)
Restriction of Waiting Order, 1979*

Notice is hereby given that Tyne and Wear County Council propose to make an Order under Section 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be:-

- (a) to revoke the existing limited waiting of twenty minutes in any one hour on the west side of Newcastle Road, Sunderland from a point 22 metres south of the southern most entrance to the Grange Hotel Forecourt in a southerly direction for a distance of 48.5 metres; and
- (b) to introduce a limited waiting of thirty minutes with return prohibited for one hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive on the length of road specified in the previous paragraph 2 (a).

Exceptions would permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle; and where necessary in connection with
- (c) the maintenance of the roads and
- (d) the supply of gas, water and electricity.
