### CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Cornwall (St. Ives) (Restrictions on Waiting) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 19th June 1979 the Cornwall County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is:

(a) to prohibit (subject to the normal exceptions operating in Cornwall) the waiting of vehicles:

(i) at any time in any of the lengths of road at St. Ives specified in the First Schedule hereto;

(ii) at any time from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in any of the lengths of road at St. Ives specified in the Second Schedule hereto

(iii) between 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in the length of road at St. Ives specified in the Third Schedule hereto;

(iv) between 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year in the length of road at St. Ives specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto;

(v) at any time (including prohibiting loading and unloading between 10 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. daily from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year) in the length of road at St. Ives specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto.
