

*Worthing Road*, north side, from Lyminster Road eastwards for 47 metres.

**Norfolk Place:**

South side, from No. 7 Norfolk Place westwards to the eastern entrance to South Passage.

All sides of the triangles situated at the northern end of Norfolk Place.

Exceptions will be contained in the Order to enable vehicles: (i) to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise; (ii) to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein; (iii) to wait in connection with weddings and funerals and (iv) to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage. Invalid carriages and disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, and a parking disc will be permitted to wait in the lengths of road above for periods of up to 2 hours, their return being prohibited within 1 hour.

**WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The County Council of West Sussex (Chichester, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979* and

*The County Council of West Sussex (Chichester, Eastgate Square) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make Orders under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit waiting at all times in the following roads in Chichester:

*Cavendish Street*, south-western arm, both sides for short lengths at its junction with Washington Street.

*Cavendish Street*, north-eastern arm, both sides for short lengths at its junction with its south-western arm.

*Washington Street*, south-western arm, both sides for short lengths at its junction with Cavendish Street.

*Theatre Lane*, both sides, for its entire length.

*Alexandra Road*, both sides, for short lengths at its junction with St. Pancras.

*Russell Street:*

west side:

(i) from its junction with Oving Road northwards for 14 metres;

(ii) from 34 metres north of Oving Road northwards for 16 metres;

east side, from Oving Road northwards for 50 metres.

*Oving Road*, north side, for short lengths at its junction with Russell Street.

*Bognor Road*, south-western side, from 265 metres north-west of York Road north-westwards to Whyke Road.

*Whyke Road*, east side, from Bognor Road, eastwards and southwards for 67 metres.

*Pound Farm Road*, both sides, for short lengths at its junction with Wyke Road.

2. To require traffic to proceed in one-way directions in accordance with the existing one-way system currently in operation in Eastgate Square, Chichester.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order in respect of 1 above to enable vehicles (i) to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise; (ii) to wait when

engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein; (iii) to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage and (iv) to wait when engaged in weddings and funerals. Invalid carriages and disabled persons vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, and a parking disc will be permitted to wait in the lengths of road in 1 above for periods of up to 2 hours, their return being prohibited within 1 hour.

Copies of the proposed Orders, maps showing the affected lengths of road, and statements of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours and at the Public Library, Tower Street, Chichester, during normal library opening hours. **WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL**

*The County Council of West Sussex (Fernhurst and Linchmere: Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979.*

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in the following lengths of road:

**Fernhurst**

*School Road*, both sides, from Camelsdale Road (B2131) northwards for 26.5 metres.

*Camelsdale Road* (B2131), north side, from School Road eastwards for 24 metres.

**Linchmere**

*New Road*, both sides, from Camelsdale Road (B2131) northwards for 14 metres.

*Hillside Road*, both sides, from Camelsdale Road (B2131) southwards for 14 metres.

North side:

(i) from New Road eastwards for 14 metres.

(ii) from New Road westwards for 18 metres.

South side, from opposite a point 18 metres west of New Road eastwards for 178 metres.

Exceptions will be contained in the Order to enable vehicles (i) to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise; (ii) to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein; (iii) to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage and (iv) to wait when engaged in weddings and funerals. Invalid carriages and disabled persons vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 and a parking disc will be permitted to wait in the lengths of road above for periods of up to 2 hours their return being prohibited within 1 hour.
