HAVANT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Havant (Service Road, New Lane, West Leigh, Havant—Prohibition of Driving) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 21st June 1979 the Council of the Borough of Havant acting on behalf of the Hampshire County Council pursuant to an arrangement entered into under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving of vehicles over those lengths of the service road situated on the western side of New Lane, West Leigh, Havant, described as follows so as to prevent the use of the service road by through vehicular traffic:

- (a) from a point 118 metres north of its junction with Farringdon Road northwards for a distance of 1 metre;
- (b) from a point 128 metres north of its junction with Farringdon Road northwards for a distance of 1 metre.

The Order will come into operation on 23rd July 1979 and a copy of it as made together with a copy of the relevant map may be inspected at the Civic Offices, Civic Centre Road, Havant, on any weekday excluding Saturdays between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B and 84C of the Act or any regulation made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hertford (Various Roads, Radlett) (One Way) Experimental Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 14th June 1979, Hertfordshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit:

- (a) vehicles from proceeding in an easterly direction along Park Road, Radlett, from its junction with Watford Road/Newlands Avenue to its junction with A5 Watling Street.
- (b) vehicles from proceeding in a westerly direction along Station Road from its junction with A5 Watling Street to its junction with Aldenham Road/Watford Road.

The Order comes into operation on 2nd July 1979 and a copy thereof and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Hertsmeire Borough Council, Civic Centre, Borehamwood, and at County Hall, Hertford, Room 204, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument

made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 14th June 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

EAST HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

East Hertfordshire District Council (Windhill, Bishop's Stortford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order (No. 52) 1979

Notice is hereby given that the East Hertfordshire District Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting on Monday to Saturday between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in Windhill, Bishop's Stortford as follows:

- (a) on the south and east sides from a point at the western end of the parking lay-by outside 'The Granary' for a distance of 46 metres west and south to a point outside number 19 Windhill,
- (b) on the west side from the junction of Windhill Old Road for a distance of 30 metres south to a point opposite 19 Windhill.

Contained in the Order are exceptions which will permit waiting for certain purposes as follows: (i) picking up and setting down passengers; (ii) loading and unloading goods; (iii) disabled persons' vehicles; (iv) maintenance of the roads and services therein; (v) building operations; and (vi) statutory purposes, including all police, fire and ambulance purposes.

A copy of the draft Order and a plan showing the proposals, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Council Offices, The Causeway, Bishop's Stortford, Monday to Friday during normal office hours.

EAST HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

East Hertfordshire District Council (Bell Lane, Hertford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order (No. 51) 1979

Notice is hereby given that the East Hertfordshire District Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting on Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in Bell Lane, Hertford as follows:

- (a) On the eastern side from a point 10 metres from its junction with Fore Street to the end of the street, a distance of 57 metres or thereabouts; and
- (b) On the western side from a point 50 metres from its junction with Fore Street to the end of the street, a distance of 16 metres or thereabouts.

Contained in the Order are exceptions which will permit waiting for certain purposes as follows: (i) picking up and setting down passengers; (ii) loading and unloading goods; (iii) disabled persons' vehicles; (iv) maintenance of the roads and services therein; (v) building operations; and (vi) statutory purposes, including all police, fire and ambulance purposes.
