Notice is hereby given that on 26th June 1979 the District Council of West Somerset, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the County Council of Somerset, made the above Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1973, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles with certain exceptions on parts of the roads at Williton as described in the Schedule below.

The Orders will come into operation on 2nd July 1979.

Exceptions are provided to enable a person to board or alight, to load or unload goods, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of roads or services therein, by local authority or Post Office vehicles for statutory duties, or by disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of these orders, together with maps showing the sides of roads affected may be inspected at the offices of the Clerk of the West Somerset District Council during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the

Orders you may, within 6 weeks from 29th June 1979, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
