NOTICE OF A PROPOSAL TO SEEK A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of Section 52 of the Water Resources Act, 1963, and Part III of the Water Resources (Licences) Regulations, 1965, the North West Water Authority is seeking a licence to extract the following quantities of water from the River Gowy adjacent to Bunbury Mill, Bunbury at National Grid Reference SJ 53 580:

HYNDBURN BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

*The Borough of Hyndburn No. 40
Smoke Control Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given, that the Hyndburn Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, on 25th September 1979, made an Order entitled the Borough of Hyndburn No. 40 Smoke Control Order 1979, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by this Order and by virtue of Section 11(2) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st November 1980, or before such later date as may be determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, St. James Street, Accrington, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 6th October 1979.
