WAGES COUNCIL

WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1979

Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council

The Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council hereby gives notice of proposals for:

- (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration and holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages (Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant) Order 1978 (Order LR(57)); and
- (2) the revocation of Order LR(57).

The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall operate from 6th October 1979.

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notice LR(58), copies of which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the proposals if made within 14 days from 12th October 1979. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council, 12 St. James's Square, London SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals LR(58).

STATE SCHEME PREMIUMS—MARKET LEVEL INDICATORS

The new state pension scheme which started in April 1978, allows contracted-out occupational pension schemes, in certain circumstances, to transfer the responsibility or part of the responsibility, for their members' guaranteed minimum pension right to the state scheme by the payment of premiums.

The premiums concerned are limited revaluation premiums, accrued rights premiums and pensioners' rights premiums. Their amounts are, in part, related to stock market levels at the time they become due and DHSS each month notifies the average market level indicator to be used in their calculation under the State Scheme Premiums (Actuarial Tables) Regulations 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 134).

For October 1979 the average market level indicator for accrued rights premiums and limited revaluation premiums is 70. The corresponding average market level indicator for pensioners' rights premiums is 75.

The average market level indicator for ARPs and LRPs shows an increase of 1 (one) since the previous month. The average market level indicator used for PRPs shows a decrease of 1 (one) since the previous month.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf has made an Order entitled the Tameside Metropolitan Borough (Arnfield Works, Audenshaw) Public Path Stopping Up Order 1979 the effect of which will be to stop up the footpath which runs from the intersection of the southern end of the footbridge crossing British Railways tracks and a point on the northern perimeter of Arnfield Works in a generally southerly direction through the works for a distance of approximately 184 yards to its junction with Bridge Street on the southern perimeter of the works.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Town Hall, Ashton-under-Lyne, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of publication of this notice but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the Order he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.

NEW TOWNS ACT 1965

EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

The New Town of Stevenage, Part of Highway Verge at the Junction of Lytton Way and Gate Way
