A PROCLAMATION

Appointing Tuesday, 1st January 1980 and Monday 5th May 1980 as Bank Holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and Wednesday, 26th December 1979 and Monday, 26th May 1980 as Bank Holidays in Scotland.

Whereas We consider it desirable that Tuesday, the first day of January and Monday, the fifth day of May in the year 1980 should be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and that Wednesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1979 and Monday, the twenty-sixth day of May in the year 1980 should be bank holidays in Scotland:

We, therefore, in pursuance of section 1 (3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Tuesday, the first day of January and Monday, the fifth day of May in the year 1980 to be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and Wednesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1979 and Monday, the twenty-sixth day of May in the year 1980 to be bank holidays in Scotland.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine and in the twenty-eighth year of Our Reign.
