*The Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Amendment Order No. 1 1979*

Notice is hereby given that the Woking Borough Council, with the consent of the County Council of Surrey, propose to make an Order under sections 31 (1) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act 1974, the effect of which will be to make the following amendments to the Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 1978:

- (a) the application of the charges in the undermentioned schedule;
- (b) an increase in the excess charge from £2 to £5 when a vehicle is left after the expiration of the period for which a charge has been paid; and

(c) an increase in the excess charge from £4 to £5 for not displaying a ticket.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours in the Chief Executive's Office, Mount Hermon Road, Woking.
