Proceedings on the above-mentioned draft Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of sections 14 (7) and 53 of the Highways Act 1971.

Objectors are reminded that the substance of their objections or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected by them; that they will be passed to the Inspector holding the Inquiries; and that in that event the Inspector may be required to disclose the objections or representations at the Inquiries and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the authors.

The Secretary of State for the Environment and the Minister of Transport hereby direct that any person who intends at the Inquiries to submit that any highway or proposed highway to which the draft Orders or any of them relate should follow an alternative route or that, instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the draft Orders or any of them relate, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to the Minister of Transport at

the North Eastern Road Construction Unit, Windsor House, Cornwall Road, Harrogate, North Yorkshire HG1 2PW not later than 7th January 1980 sufficient information about the alternative route to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the Minister and the person holding the Inquiries to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.

Any person who proposes to make a submission about an alternative route for a highway or proposed highway, or about the construction of a new highway on a particular route instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway, is reminded of the power of the Secretary of State for the Environment and the Minister of Transport to disregard objections which in their opinion amount to substance to objections to The Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (Brigg By-Pass to Grimsby Section and Slip Roads) Order 1979.—Dated 26th November 1979.
