ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Wiltshire (East Gomeldon Road, Gomeldon) (One-Way) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 4th December 1979, the Wiltshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, providing for the one-way working of traffic on the following lengths of road in Gomeldon:

Lengths of Road and Direction of Travel

(A) The Northern Leg of East Gomeldon Road from its junction with Gomeldon Road for a distance of approximately 55 metres with traffic only being allowed to travel in an easterly direction.

(B) The Southern Leg of East Gomeldon Road from its junction with the Northern Leg for approximately 60 metres to its junction with Gomeldon Road.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the above Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulation made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WOLVERHAMPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Wolverhampton (Shaw Lane, Tettenhall) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 6th December 1979 the Wolverhampton Borough Council acting on behalf of the West Midlands County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended. The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 10th December 1979 is to prohibit parking at any time on any day in Shaw Lane, Tettenhall. The prohibition on waiting will replace the existing restriction on waiting from 8.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday. The Order contains exemptions for boarding and alighting from vehicles, loading and unloading, and building, demolition and similar operations.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the Civic Centre, St. Peter's Square, Wolverhampton.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of sections 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks of 6th December 1979 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The South Yorkshire County Council (West End Lane and Grange Lane, Rossington) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 28th November 1979, the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 10th December 1979 will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles in any of the sides or lengths of roads at Rossington in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, the supply of gas, water and electricity, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles are also included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads the subject of the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of:

- (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley; and
- (ii) Rossington Branch Library, McConnell Crescent, Rossington near Doncaster.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 28th November 1979, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Roads at Rossington in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster

West End Lane :

North side, from a point 41 metres west of the western kerb-line of Balcarres Road for a distance of 126 metres in a westerly direction ;

South side, from a point 17 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Bevan Avenue for a distance of 151 metres in a westerly direction.

Grange Lane :

North-west side, from its junction with the southern kerb-line of West End Lane for a distance of 21 metres in a south-westerly direction ;

South-east side, from its junction with the southern kerb-line of West End Lane for a distance of 40 metres in a south-westerly direction. (485)

The South Yorkshire County Council (Neale Road, Wheatley Park, Doncaster) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 28th November 1979, the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 10th December 1979, will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday:

- (a) in either of the sides of Neale Road, Wheatley Park in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster specified in the Schedule to this notice; and
- (b) other than for a period of 1 hour in 4 hours on the north-east side of Neale Road, Wheatley Park in the Metropolitan District of Doncaster from a point 62 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of Wheatley Hall Road for a distance of 40 metres in a north-westerly direction.
