The County of Devon (Recreation Road/Beacon Park, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on any day in Recreation Road on its east side from a point 115 metres (126 yards) south of its junction with Ham Drive southwards to its junction with Beacon Park Road.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services.

Exceptions will also be provided for vehicles used by disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Belgrave Road (North)/Connaught Lane, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the following lengths of road:

(i) Belgrave Lane (North)—both sides from the junction with Mutley Plain Lane eastwards for a distance of 12 metres (13 yards).

(ii) Connaught Lane—both sides from the junction with Mutley Plain Lane eastwards for a distance of 6 metres (7 yards).

Exceptions will be provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services.

Exceptions will also be provided for vehicles used by disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (New Promenade, Aberystwyth) (H.M. Coastguard's Parking Places) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd December 1979 the Dyfed County Council made an Order under sections 28(1) and 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit parking on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto except for vehicles of H.M. Coastguard parked in the positions and for the time specified in the Schedule.

The Order will come into operation on 10th December 1979, and a copy of the Order, together with a map indicating the length of road affected may be inspected at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
