### SCARBOROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

(AS AGENT OF THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL)

*The Borough of Scarborough (Newlands Park Crescent, Scarborough) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1979.*

Notice is hereby given that the Scarborough Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3), (3AA) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, (as amended).

Its effect will be to prohibit the driving of heavy commercial vehicles in the length of Newlands Park Crescent which extends from its junction with Vernon Grove to its

northerly junction with Newlands Park Drive ("Heavy Commercial Vehicle" means any vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of goods and has an unladen weight exceeding 3 tons).

The Order will contain exceptions enabling a heavy commercial vehicle to be driven on the length of road concerned if it is being used:

- for the conveyance of goods to or from premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road (and no suitable alternative means of access is available);
- for the purpose of agriculture on land adjacent to that length of road or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
