*(Chapel Street and Crabbery Street, Stafford) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 7th December 1979 the Stafford Borough Council made the above-named Order under section (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.
