GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Thornbrake Road Area)
(Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 9) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council as Agents for the Hampshire County Council on 12th December 1979, made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Order comes into operation on 19th December 1979, and the effect will be as follows:—

Prohibition of waiting at anytime

- (1) Dock Road both sides from its junction with Cranbourne Road, northwards for a short distance.
- (2) Cranbourne Road (a) the north side from a point 6m east of its junction with Dock Road to a point 16m west of that junction.
(b) the south side from a point 22m east of its junction with Thornbrake Road to a point 14m west of that junction.
- (3) Thornbrake Road (a) the east side
(b) the west side
(i) from its junction with Cranbourne Road southwards for a short distance.
(ii) from its junction with Mayfield Road northwards for a short distance.
- (4) Old Road both sides from its junction with Mayfield Road southwards for a short distance.
- (5) Mayfield Road both sides from a point 14m west of its junction with Thornbrake Road to a point 14m east of that junction.

Full details of these proposals together with the Order and plan showing the restricted areas may be examined in my Department at The Town Hall, High Street, Gosport, from Monday to Friday during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 12th December apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Winchester (Berewecke Avenue|Stoney Lane)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Winchester City Council with the consent of the Hampshire County Council have made the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times in the lengths of road set out in the Schedule to this Notice.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 31st December 1979 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Berewecke Avenue	Both	From its junction with Stoney Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
Stoney Lane	South	From its junction with Berewecke Avenue in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
Stoney Lane	South	From its junction with Berewecke Avenue in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1949

Survey of Rights of Way

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their duty under Part IV of the above Act, hereby give notice that, having determined and decided what modifications shall be made to the Draft Map prepared under the Act, following objections and representations under sub sections (3) and (4) (b) of section 29 of the Act, and the appeals to the Minister of Housing and Local Government duly made under sub section (5) of section 29 of the Act having been determined, they have prepared a Provisional Map under section 30 of the Act in respect of the County together with statements containing particulars thereof. The Provisional Map is a reproduction of the Draft Map incorporating the above-mentioned modifications.

Copies of the Provisional Map and Statement have been deposited at County Hall, High Street, Newport, where they may be inspected during the usual office hours.

Any owner, lessee or occupier of land over which any of the paths run may apply to the Crown Court for a determination of any dispute concerning the contents of the map and statement.

Notice of any such application should be given in writing to The Chief Clerk, Newport Crown Court, 2nd Floor, Great Western House, Isambard Brunel Road, Portsmouth within 28 days after the publication of this notice, and shall specify the land to which the application relates, the grounds upon which the application is made and the name of the surveying authority, ie The County Council of Isle of Wight and the applicant shall serve a copy of such notice upon every other person appearing to the applicant to be the owner, lessee or occupier of the said land or of any other land specified in the application in regard to which the Court may make declaration, and upon the County Council of Isle of Wight. Applicants should consult the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations 1952 (SI. 1952 No. 559) as amended by the Public Rights of Way (Applications to the Crown Court) Regulations 1972 (SI. 1972 No. 93).
