The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Gedling Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under S.212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of High Street Avenue, Arnold and provide for a turning facility adjacent to this length.
