Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 (4) and 109 (6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Anglian Water Authority under section 11 (1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, making provision for the abolition of the Nene Valley Drainage and Navigation Improvement Commissioners (First District) and the Nene Valley Drainage and Navigation Improvement Commissioners (Second District) and the Drainage Boards thereof.

The Order will become final and have effect as an act of Parliament unless during the period ending with 16th January 1980 a memorial is presented to the Minister by

some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965 (S.I. 1965/443) as applied to Water Authorities by section 9 of the Water Act 1973) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A COMBINED LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AND INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS AND TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn Trent Water Authority by The University of Aston in Birmingham, of Gosta Green, Birmingham B4 7ET for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of River Tean at Checkley by means of reinforced rubble impoundment of natural river stones at Grid. 189 cubic metres (41,666 gallons) per hour;

4,546 cubic metres (1 million gallons) per day;

1,659,290 cubic metres (365 million gallons) per year from the said inland water at or near that point.
