Notice is hereby given that on 3rd December 1979 the Cornwall County Council (with the consent of the Minister of Transport) made an Order under section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is that the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto shall become subject to a speed limit of 40 m.p.h.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the length of road referred to therein, will be available for public inspection between the hours of 9.30 a.m.—12.30 p.m. and 2.30 p.m.—4 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the County Hall, Truro.

The Order will come into operation on 20th December 1979.

DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Various Roads, Pembroke) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and section 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of this Order will be:

To amend the County of Dyfed (Various Roads, Pembroke) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977, (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1977") as follows:—

- (a) The description of the length of road set out in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice where waiting is prohibited at all times will be replaced by the description set out in Column 2 of Schedule 1.
- (b) The description of the side of road set out in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice where waiting is restricted to 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. will be replaced by the description set out in Column 2 of Schedule 2.

The provision of the Order of 1977 whereby waiting is limited to 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. will not longer apply on Sundays to any of the lengths or sides of roads affected by such provision.

To prohibit waiting at all times in the length and on the sides of roads set out in Schedule 3 to this notice.

To restrict waiting to 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on all days except Sunday on the side of road set out in Schedule 4 to this notice.

To revoke the provisions set out in Schedule 5 to this notice which no longer apply.

The exemptions contained in the Order of 1977, including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, and for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage, situated on or adjacent to any of the lengths and sides of road specified in the Order of 1977 will continue to apply and similarly, the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the lengths and sides of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, and at the offices of the Area Surveyor, Grove, Pembroke during normal office hours.
