

(b) to prohibit waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the north side of the service road, Kingsway, from 55 metres west of Chester Road (A56) to a point opposite Pinnington Lane.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading and unloading, funerals, building operations or work on or under the length of road. In addition, disabled person's vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours return prohibited within 1 hour.

GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Service Areas adjoining Brewery Street and Post Office Street, Altringham) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1979.

Notice is hereby given that on 6th December 1979 the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at all times on:

POWYS COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Powys (College Road, Builth Wells) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 5th December 1979, the County Council of Powys made the above-named Order

under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order makes it unlawful to drive a vehicle in either direction along the length of the County Unclassified Road No. 852 known as College Road, Builth Wells, which extends for a distance of 140 metres from its junction with the B4475, Park Road, to its junction with North Road, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Exceptions will permit entry for the purpose of access and pursuance of statutory duties.

An alternative route for traffic in Park Road seeking to gain access to North Road is as follows:

from the junction with College Road, proceed in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 120 metres to the junction with North Road. Traffic in North Road travelling in the opposite direction should proceed to the aforementioned junction with Park Road.

The Order will come into operation on the 17th December 1979. A copy of the Order and a map showing both the length of road affected by the prohibition and the alternative route may be examined during office hours at:

POWYS COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Powys (Duffryn Road, Llangynidr) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 5th December 1979, the County Council of Powys made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order, which makes it unlawful to leave a vehicle at any time along either of the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice, will come into operation on the 17th December 1979.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (b) loading or unloading goods and, where necessary, in connection with:
- (c) the maintenance of the roads, and

The Order also contains an exception permitting disabled persons' vehicles to park for a period not exceeding 2 hours, with return within 1 hour prohibited.
