The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in that length of the west side of Dara Street at Wincobank, Sheffield which extends from its junction with the northern kerb line of Standon Road for a distance of 23 metres in a northerly direction.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the road(s) and the services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets.
