ISLE OF ANGLESEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
TOWN AND COUNTRY AMENITIES ACT 1974

Bodedern Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Ynys Mon-Isle of Anglesey in pursuance of its powers under section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 have designated that that part of Ynys Mon-Isle of Anglesey described in the schedule below as a Conservation area.

Plans showing the Conservation area may be inspected during office hours from Monday to Friday inclusive at the Planning Department, Borough Council Offices, Llangefni, Ynys Mon.

Attention is drawn to the effect of designation on the control of demolition of buildings and on the felling, lopping or the damaging of trees within the Conservation area.

Section 277A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, applies to all buildings in Conservation areas other than:—

- (a) Listed buildings (which are subject to control under other legislation).
- (b) "Excepted" buildings under section 58(2) of the Act (Churches, Chapels, Ancient monuments which are subject to control and other regulations).
- (c) Buildings specified in a direction by the Secretary of State, and requires that any building to which section 277A applies shall not be demolished without the consent of the Secretary of State.

Section 61A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 applies to all trees within a Conservation area other than trees included in Tree Preservation Orders and prohibits the cutting down, lopping, topping, uprooting, wilful damage or wilful destruction of trees, except with the consent of the local planning authority or where a tree is dangerous.

Description of area

The area is bounded on the north side by the rear boundaries of Tyn Llan, 1 Church Street, St. Edeyrn's Church Yard and the Crown Hotel car park. From along the east side of the car park the boundary then crosses to the south side of Church Street then east to include the Memorial Hall and south along its boundary wall westwards in front of the new primary school to link with the rear wall of Pen y Groeslon.

The boundary then crosses Wesley Street and follows the south side of Tyn Rardd then south and west including the houses Ardwyn and Ceris, it then includes the Baptist Chapel and crosses Baptist Street.

Along the rear boundary of Plas Main council housing estate the boundary of the Conservation Area follows a north westerly direction to cross London Road to include 32 London Road and 7 Chapel Street.

The boundary then continues northwards along the east side of Chapel Street, north west and then north along the rear boundary walls of number 2–18 London Road.

Finally, the boundary follows the north side of Church Street westerly and then northwards so as to include Tyn Llan.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

The London Borough of Lewisham (Perryfields) Article 4 Direction 1979

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Article 4 (6) of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") that the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham have made the London Borough of Lewisham (Perryfields) Article 4 Direction 1979 in respect of the land known as numbers 1 to 45 (odd) Perry Rise, 1 to 35 (odd) and 2 to 24 (even) Allenby Road, and 1 to 29 (odd) and 2 to 40 (even) Garlies Road, London SE23.

The effect of the Direction is to make it necessary for planning permission to be obtained for the carrying out of any development of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto on such part of the said land as are set out in the corresponding part of Column 2 of the Schedule hereto which would otherwise be permitted development within the meaning of Article 3 of the Order.

This Direction shall come into force on 13th December 1979 and shall remain in force for 6 months from the date hereof and shall then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date. If the Secretary of State for the Environment does so approve this Direction, it shall be of permanent effect.

A copy of this Direction and a plan identifying the land affected may be inspected at the office of the Borough Solicitor (Room 335), Lewisham Town Hall Catford SE6 between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. and any enquiries regarding the Direction or its effect may be made to the Borough Solicitor.
