CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Borough of Cheltenham Area Number 10 (College Gardens) Smoke Control Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the Cheltenham Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on 12th December 1979 made an Order entitled "The Borough of Cheltenham Area Number 10 (College Gardens) Smoke Control Order 1980" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an aut orised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st September 1980, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, Cheltenham (Town Clerk and Chief Executive's Department) at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 1st January 1980.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area to which this Order relates is off Marsh Lane, Cheltenham and is bounded to the west and north by allotment gardens to the east by the Cheltenham-Honeybourne railway line and to the south by land owned by the College of St. Paul and St. Mary and comprises an area of 4.75 acres and is known as College Gardens.
