*The Kent County Council (London Road and Hermitage Lane, Aylesford) (Experimental Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) (Extension) Order (No. 2) 1979.*

Notice is hereby given that on 13th December 1979, the Kent County Council made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. #### KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Kent County Council (Sheppey Way, A249, Iwade) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 13th December 1979, the Kent County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the purpose of which is to prohibit vehicles, other than buses, from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays at the bus stop layby situated on Sheppey Way (A249) Iwade on the east side, south of School Lane, where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop, and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway.

Other vehicles will be permitted to wait in the above bus stop layby only with police permission or where necessary:

- (a) for the removal of an obstruction to traffic;
- (b) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers;
- (c) in certain emergencies; or
- (d) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

*The Lancashire County Council (Barker Brow/Ribchester Road, B6245; Clayton-le-Dale, Ribbles Valley Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 19*
