The Trunk Road (Various Lengths of Road)

(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended. The effect of the Order will be:

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction or potential obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

An exception has also been provided in the Order to allow a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on the lengths of lay-by and lengths of superseded trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to the Notice.
