ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967
The Greater Manchester County (Union Street, Royton)
Prohibition of Waiting
(Borough) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Oldham Borough Council, acting pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the Greater Manchester County Council, have today made an Order under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The Order will come into operation on 17th December 1979.

Exemptions

- (a) to enable persons to board or alight from a vehicle
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle.
- (c) vehicles used for building or demolition operations, funerals, weddings, roadworks, works on sewers or statutory powers and duties
- (d) vehicles used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties
- (e) disabled persons vehicles for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within one hour

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of roads referred to may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 17th December 1979 apply to the High Court for the purpose.—Dated 17th December 1979.

The Hove Borough Council (Palmeira)
(Traffic Regulation) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that Hove Borough Council as agents for East Sussex County Council on 14th December 1979 made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended. The Order comes into operation on 7th January 1980.

The Order prohibits the driving of vehicles in the lengths of road mentioned in column 1 below in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 2 below:

The Order prohibits the waiting of vehicles, subject to the usual exemptions:

- (a) At all times in parts of the following roads:
Church Road
Western Road
Salisbury Road
Palmeira Avenue
Rochester Gardens
Palmeira Square

and around the perimeter of 2 traffic islands to be formed between St. John the Baptist's Church and Palmeira Lawn.

(b) Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on part of the west side of St. John's Road.

(c) Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a longer period than 60 minutes (return prohibited within 60 minutes) in parts of Western Road and Church Road.
