NORTHAMPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 TRANSPORT ACT 1968** LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 The Northampton Borough Council (Central Area) (General Traffic Control) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that the Northampton Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as the Council) pursuant to arrange-ments made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Northamptonshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1, 5, 28 and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended intend to make an order the effect of which will be:

- (i) To replace and alter the existing general scheme of traffic control in the Central Area;
- (ii) To prohibit the waiting of any vehicle and the loading and unloading of any vehicle between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on
- unloading of any vehicle between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the roads or lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
  (iii) To authorise and regulate parking between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the parts of the roads specified in the Third Schedule hereto;
  (iv) To revoke the existing Orders specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

The waiting, loading and unloading prohibition shall not apply to certain specified operations such as the boarding or alighting from a vehicle, the removal or delivery of furniture, hackney carriages within cab ranks, or anything done with the

permission of a uniformed police officer. The draft Order together with a map illustrating its effect and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at my office at No. 61 Derngate, Northampton during Office Hours.

Anyone wishing to object to the proposed Order should send his objections and the grounds for making them, in writing, to reach me by 10th January 1980.
