

GWENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gwent County Council (High Street and Various Roads, Newbridge) (Parts) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that:

- The Gwent County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84 D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be:
- To prohibit waiting at any time on those lengths of road as set out in the Schedule hereto.
- Exceptions will be provided in the Order for:
 - picking up and setting down passengers
 - loading or unloading goods
 - the maintenance of the roads
 - the supply of gas, electricity and water
 - for emergency purposes.
- Full details of these proposals are in the Draft Order, which together with a map showing the restricted area and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of the Islwyn Borough Council, Civic Centre, Pontllanfraith, and the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours Monday to Friday.
- If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 21st January 1980.

SCHEDULE

A472 High Street

- Both sides from the western kerb-line of Ebbw View Terrace to a point 200 metres in a westerly direction from the western kerb-line of Ty-Llwydd Place.
- Northern side from a point 278 metres in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western kerb-line of Ty-Llwydd Place for a distance of 40 metres in a westerly direction.
- Southern side from a point 324 metres in a westerly direction from the western kerb-line of Ty-Llwydd Place to its junction with A472 Bryngwyn Road.

A472 Bryngwyn Road

- Northern side from a point 7 metres in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western boundary of Halls Road for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction.
- Southern side from its junction with A472 High Street to the eastern boundary of Halls Road.

Victoria Lane

Both sides from the western kerb-line of A472 High Street to the eastern kerb-line of Victoria Terrace.

Victoria Terrace

- Eastern side from the northern kerb-line of A472 High Street to the southern kerb-line of Park Hill.
- Western side from the northern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 10 metres.

Tynnewydd Terrace

- North-eastern side from the northern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 20 metres.
- South-western side from the northern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 30 metres.

Main Street

- Eastern side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 10 metres.
- Western side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 15 metres.

West View

Both sides from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 10 metres.

Meredith Terrace

- North-eastern side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 25 metres.
- South-western side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 10 metres.

Ty-Llwydd Place

- Eastern side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 46 metres.
- Western side from the southern kerb-line of A472 High Street for a distance of 15 metres.
- Northern side for its whole length.

The Gwent County Council (Various Roads, Newbridge) (One-Way Traffic) Order 19

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84 D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84 C (1) of the Act, intend to make an order the effect of which will be:

- To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the roads or lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to the roads or lengths of road in Column 2 of the Schedule.
- Copies of the proposed Order together with a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, together with a plan showing the affected roads may be inspected at the offices of the Islwyn Borough Council, Civic Centre, Pontllanfraith, and the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday).
- Objections should be made in writing and sent to the undersigned by 21st January 1980.

Traffic Regulation Orders, Chepstow Road Area, Newport

Notice is hereby given that the Gwent County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, have on 14th December 1979, made two traffic regulation orders for the above area, which will come into operation on 5th March 1980.

The effect of the orders are:

(i) *Chepstow Road, A48, Beechwood Road, Somerton Road and Other Roads, Newport, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading*

Vehicles may not wait:

- At any time on parts of Chepstow Road, Beechwood Road, Somerton Road, Warwick Road, Hawarden Road, Kenilworth Road, Carey Road, Mansel Street, Linden Road (loading or unloading will not be permitted on parts of Chepstow Road and Somerton Road between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays).
- Between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays on parts of Chepstow Road and Somerton Road (loading or unloading will not be permitted during these hours).

(ii) *Chepstow Road/Warwick Road, Chepstow Road/Carey Road, Newport Prohibition of Right Turns*

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in:—

- Chepstow Road to make right turns into Carey Road and Warwick Road.
- Warwick Road to make a right turn into Chepstow Road.

Exemptions have been provided in Order (i) to permit waiting for the purpose of:

- picking up and setting down passengers
- loading and unloading goods (in part of the order only)
- loading or unloading furniture from a house or office
- delivery or collection of postal packets
- the maintenance of the roads
- the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraphic line
