

3. That length of Charlotte Street which extends from its junction with Hayes Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 24 yards.

4. That length of New Street which extends from its junction with Hayes Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction, then south-easterly direction to its junction with Tredegar Street.

5. That narrow strip of highway on the north side of Customhouse Street which extends from its junction with Hope Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 25 yards.

6. That small triangular shaped area of highway with a maximum width of 4½ feet, which lies approximately 23 yards north-east of the Bute Monument.
