

Explanatory Note

These regulations further amend the Social Security (Benefit) (Married Women and Widows Special Provisions) Regulations 1974. They insert into those regulations a new regulation modifying paragraphs 4 (1) and 4A (1) of Schedule 1 to the Social Security Pensions Act 1975 (increase of

retirement pension where woman's deceased husband had deferred retirement) in their application to widows who remarry before attaining pensionable age to ensure that such a widow will not inherit increments of pension from a previous husband.
