## WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Watford (Shrubbery Car Park Access Road) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 20th December 1979 the Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire, made the above Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of vehicles in that length of the Shrubbery Car Park Access Road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this notice other than in the direction referred to in column 2 of that Schedule.

An exemption will permit the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle or gully emptying machine.

The Order will come into operation on 9th January 1980.

*The Borough of Watford (Shrubbery Car Park Access Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 20th December 1979 the Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with

the County Council of Hertfordshire, made the above Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting of vehicles as follows:

*No waiting at any time*

*Shrubbery Car Park Access Road.*

Both sides – from its junction with The Parade, High Street to its junction with Rosslyn Road.

The usual exemptions will apply.

An exemption will also permit the boarding of coaches (part of south-east side only, as indicated by road markings).

## WAVERLEY DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Waverley District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 18th December 1979 the Waverley District Council made an Order under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act 1974.
