DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Minister of Transport hereby gives Notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (County of Suffolk) (No. 2) Order 1979". Extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on lengths of Stone Lodge Lane, Ipswich, Suffolk and requiring the provision of a new highway.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Department of Transport at the Office of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Eastern Region, quoting 537941/17/04 and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Ipswich Borough Council, Civic Centre, Civic Drive, Ipswich.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 27th December 1979, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
